New Functionality Allows Users to Easily add 25-person Face-to-Face Video and Screen Sharing while Collaborating in Teambox

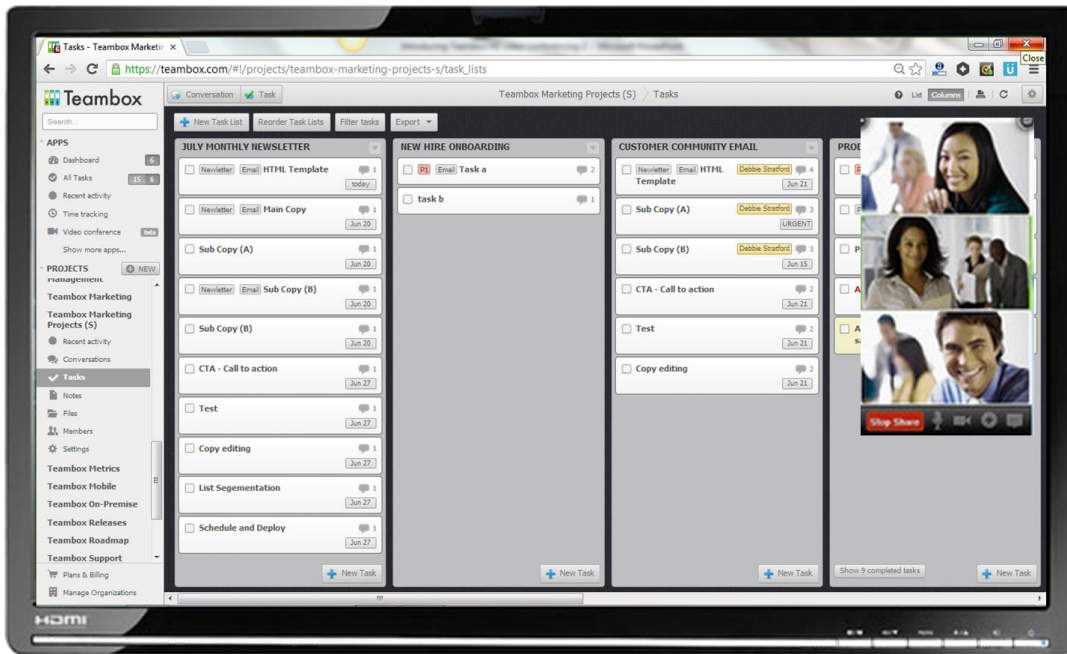
